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Details technical specifications for Roll stability apparatus for room temperature test are given below

Technical Specification for High Temperature Roll Stability Test Apparatus

- **Standard Test Specification Details:** The equipment is suitable for testing shell roll stability (shear stability) of lubricating greases as per ASTM D 1831 with capability for testing at higher temperatures.
- **Model Detail and Requirement:** The roll stability test apparatus should be compact in size, easy to operate and should have the arrangement to run two test at a time in different rolls so that working by rotating rollers on two different samples of lubricating greases can be done simultaneously in two separate cylinders at specified temperature. & speed.
- Cylinders: Cylinders should be made of stainless steel and size and diameter (outer and inner) should be as per ASTM D 1831. Cylinders should be provided with threaded screw cap and should be of leak proof (provided with gasket of suitable material to prevent leakage).
- **Rollers:** Rollers should be made of stainless steel. Size and diameter of the rollers should be as per ASTM D 1831 method. Roller weight should be 5 Kg +/- 50g.
- RPM capacity: Speed of roll stability test apparatus should be capable of performing the test at 165 +/- 15 RPM.
- **Heating Capacity:** Air heating bath capable of maintaining the temperature from <u>ambient to 150 Deg C</u>. Instrument should be provided with a fan for air circulation to uniformly maintaining the temperature inside the test chamber.
- **Temperature Display:** Provided with digital temperature control and display with suitable senor for accurate indication of the temperature inside the equipment.
- **Safety aspect of the Instrument:** The instrument must be safe to operate. Should be with safety device for overheating protection.
- **Timer:** Roll stability test apparatus should have the provision with digital/electronic timer with preset for stopping the test at the end of the test time. (this will be the added feature)
- **Calibration Certificate:** Roll stability test apparatus should be provided with calibration certificate for speed and temperature controllers from NABL accredited laboratory.
- **Rolling Bearings and pulleys:** The bearing and pulleys on which the test cylinder rotates should be sturdy enough to withstand the temperature and long lasting.



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Spares & Consumables: The necessary spares & consumables required for two years of smooth operation of the instrument must be provided.

Warranty/ Guarantee: Parties should provide the warranty / guarantee for smooth running of the instrument for one year and one year additional free service warranty after completion of one year standard warranty/guarantee period.

Technical Literature Support: The technical details of the instrument (with all above units) offered along with the application notes. The necessary manuals including instruction & operating manual must be provided.

Dimensions, Weight and Power requirements of the instrument with all the units must be specified.

12. Payment terms:

- (i) 90% on 30 days credit after supply, successful demo & commissioning & delivery of complete technical literature and submission of bill along with all taxes and duties as applicable.
- (i) Balance 10 % of PO Value shall be kept as retention money & will be released after completion of guarantee period without any interest or against submission of performance bank guarantee.
- (ii) PBG shall be furnished in specified format and shall be valid for the warranty period from the date of successful commissioning.

13. Liquidated damages: -

a) Vendor shall be liable to pay liquidated damages for the following:

Failure to deliver the material as per PO and delivery schedule. In such case, vendor shall be liable to pay liquidated damages @ 0.5% of PO value per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 5.0%.

- **18.** User manuals and instruction booklets shall be supplied with the equipment (2 hard copies and 1 soft copy).
- 19. Guarantee Period: Vendor shall guarantee against any and all defects in design, workmanship, materials and performance for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of supply of the devices. If any defects develop during the guarantee period, it shall be remedied promptly free of charge by the supplier and all expenses for transportation of goods necessitated for such repairs or replacement shall be borne by the supplier. Additional one year free service warranty is to be provided
- **20. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:** Notwithstanding anything contrary contained herein, the aggregate total liability of Seller under the agreement or otherwise shall be limited to 100% of order Price. However, neither party shall be liable to the other for any indirect and consequential damages, loss of profits or loss of production.
- **21.** Force Majeure: Shall mean and be limited to the following
 - (a) War / Hostilities (b)Riot or Civil Commotion (c) Earthquake, flood, tempest, lighting or other natural disasters (d) Restrictions imposed by the Government or other statutory bodies which prevents or delays the execution of the Contract by the Seller . The Seller shall advise Purchaser/Consultant by a registered letter duly certified by the local Chamber of Commerce or statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the above causes of delay within seven (7) days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure conditions, In the event of delay lasting over one month, if arising out of causes of Force Majeure, Purchaser reserves the right to cancel the Contract and the provisions governing termination stated under Article 28 above shall apply .For delays arising out of Force Majeure, the Seller shall not claim extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delay attributable to the causes of Force Majeure and neither Purchaser nor Seller shall be liable to pay extra costs provided it is mutually established that Force Majeure conditions did actually exist. Seller shall categorically specify the extent of Force Majeure conditions prevalent in their works at the time of submitting their bid and whether the same have been taken into consideration or not in their



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quotations. In the event of any Force Majeure conditions, the Seller or the Purchaser shall not be liable for delays in performing their obligations under this order and the delivery dates will be extended to the Seller without being subject to price reduction for delayed deliveries, asstated elsewhere.

22. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES / ARBITRATION
