2. Bid Validity

The offer shall remain valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of the Price Bid which will be normally two weeks from opening of Technical Bid.

3. Bid Rejection Criteria

A bid may be rejected if

- i. If the bidder fails to send the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/Bid Bond amount within the bid due date.
- ii. If the bidder does not meet the pre-qualification/technical criteria and/or non submission of documents specified.
- iii. The deviations from the terms mentioned in the document affects in any way the scope, quality and performance.

Re-siting of machines at IP-Sewree to our upcoming plant at Vadodara located within 50km radius from Vadodara. Job includes cleaning, lubrication, filtration, activation, Repair, Dismantling, painting, lifting, shifting, loading of machines at IP-Sewree & unloading, lifting, shifting, locating at places as directed by BL officer in charge, erection, commissioning & trial run of these machines at our upcoming plant located within 50km radius from Vadodara"

Details of Scope of work for above machines-

- 1. Cleaning of machines & electrical control panels. Lubrication of all moving parts of machines. Replacement of hoses, poly urethane airlines. Decanting, cleaning of hydraulic power packs. Filtration of hydraulic oil. Refilling power packs with filtered or new oil.
- 2. Activation of machines. Rectifications of issues, problems observed during activation. Again reactivation of machines & ensuring smooth running before dismantling in presence of officer in charge at IP-Sewree. Replacement of worn out/damaged parts/hardware's/hoses/oils/oil seals, etc. as per requirement as observed during activation of machines. - **3.** Dismantling of machines, equipment, tooling & control panels along with inter connecting up ender, down ender ,conveyors & other accessories with proper marking & noting's in such a manner that machines can be re-started at the earliest after re-sitting. Dismantling of two m s. chimneys & cleaning. After inspection if found useful then to be loaded in truck otherwise to be kept at place as instructed by officer in charge.

- **4.** Through cleaning & painting of machines, control panels, conveyors, motors, gear boxes guards & accessories at IP-Sewree as instructed by officer in charge. The two coats of paint are to be applied. Color shade as advised & approved by officer in charge. The paint, thinner, spray gun, brushes, cleaning material etc. is in the scope of bidder.
- **5.** Lifting, shifting, packing as required or instructed by officer in charge & loading of above items as instructed by officer in charge in trucks with proper safety for **transportation to Vadodara**.

Delivery/Job Completion Period:

- Unloading, positioning, Erection, commissioning & trial of machines within 4 months after site clearance from BL at Vadodara.
- Total job to be completed within 5 months from date of award of contract.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGE (LD):

In case, the successful bidder fails to supply and execute services within the stipulated period as per the Purchase Order, Liquidated Damages will be imposed @ 0.50% of the Total Purchase Order Value, per completed week up to a maximum of 5% of the total Purchase Order value

Annexure IV

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Introduction

The bidder means the firm or company with whom the order is placed and shall be deemed to include the bidder, successors, representatives, heirs, executors and administrators.

Whenever there is a duplication of clause in the terms and conditions, the clause which is beneficial to BL will be considered applicable at the time of any dispute.

Scope of Supply

Scope of work for the tender shall be as mentioned in Annexure II.

Reference for Documentation

Purchase Order Number must appear on all correspondence, drawings, invoices, packing and on any documents or papers connected with the order.

Confirmation of Order

The successful bidder shall acknowledge the receipt of purchase order within 10 days following the mailing of this order in writing or through email and shall thereby confirm his acceptance of purchase order in entirely without exceptions

Payment Terms

The terms of payment are as mentioned in Payment Terms under Special Terms & Conditions of the Tender.

Rejection of Bids

The bid of any bidder may be rejected if a conflict of interest between the bidder and BL is detected at any state. BL reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. The decision of BL in this connection will be final.

Delays

Delay in Bidding

Late tenders / delayed tenders including postal delay and those not conforming to the prescribed conditions will not be considered.

Bidder needs to ensure that both the Technical/Pre-Qualification as well as Price bids are submitted on or before the Tender closing date and time. Failure to submit either of the two (i.e. Technical/Pre-Qualification as well as Price bid) shall call for immediate disqualification and the Technical/Pre-Qualification bid will not be considered for further evaluation

Delay in Delivery/Completion of the job

The bidder shall ensure to complete the delivery/complete the job as mentioned in the scope of work within the stipulated time as mentioned in Delivery/Job Completion Period under Special Terms & Conditions of the Tender. Delays in delivery or completion will attract Liquidated damages as mentioned in Special Terms & Conditions Clause of the Tender document.

Delay due to Force Majeure

If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions or acts of God (hereinafter referred to as events) then provided notice of the happening any such events if given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall be by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non-

performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of the HEAD (IP), Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd., as to whether the deliveries has been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any such event for period exceeding 60 days, either party may at its option terminate the agreement.

Sub-Contracts

The successful bidder shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of BL. Owner can disown any responsibility for any irregularity or contravention of any of the statutory regulations in the manufacture or supply of goods covered in the order. The Bidder shall ensure compliance with the above and shall indemnify tenderer against any actions, damages, costs and expenses of any failure to comply as aforesaid.

The successful bidder will be responsible for the welfare and discipline of his employees inside our factory. He must also undertake to comply with all statutory regulations for employment of his employees. Any expenses incurred by us under these regulations will have to be reimbursed by him. The successful bidder will be deemed to be the ultimate employer of his men.

General Obligations regarding workmen engaged by the successful bidder for working inside the factory / office premises.

Scaffolding
