Glimpses from the City of Joy



Birla Mandir in Kolkata is a Hindu temple built by the industrialist Birla family. The construction of the temple began in 1970. It took 26 years to complete the entire structure. On Wednesday, the 21st of February, 1996, the Pran Prathistha was done by Swami Chidanandaji Maharaj in the morning. Dr. Karan Singh inaugurated the temple the same day. The main temple houses statues of deities Krishna and Radha. This temple built of white marble bears resemblance to the renowned Lingaraj Temple of Bhubaneswar. Birla Mandir also showcases pictorial depiction of scriptures of Bhagvad Gita in its stone engravings and some intricate Rajasthani temple architecture.
