



EDITORIAL

The annual financial results for the year 2017-18 and the results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2018 were announced on 29th May. The results were approved by the Board in its Meeting held in New Delhi on the same day. The company had yet another year of excellent performance and posted the highest ever profits in its history. The total income for the fourth quarter of the FY 2017-18 decreased by 3.34% and stood at Rs 517.31 crores as compared to the same period last year. While the Profit Before Tax (PBT) for the quarter ended 31st March 2018 was Rs 116.22 crores, the net profit (PAT) for the quarter was Rs 87.95 crores. The gross income of the company stood at Rs 1830.14 crores for the year ended 31st March 2018. The net income clocked was Rs 1797.10 crores registering a growth of 1% in net turnover on the levels achieved in 2016-17. While the PBT for the year ended 31st March 2018 increased by 2.76% to Rs 261.12 crores, the PAT increased by 8.45% and stood at Rs 184.82 crores. All the six Strategic Business Units continued to register profits and the Board of Directors has recommended a dividend of 100% for the financial year 2017-18 as against 70% dividend paid for the year 2016-17.

We are happy to report that Mr. A Ratna Sekhar has taken over as Director [HR & Corporate Affairs] with effect from 2nd May, 2018. Mr. Ratna Sekhar will be overseeing the Human Resources, Corporate Communications, HSE and CSR functions of the company. Working in Confined Spaces


Confined space refers to any place, including any vessel, tank, container, pit, bund, chamber, cellar or any other similar space which, by virtue of its enclosed nature, creates conditions that give rise to a likelihood of an accident, harm or injury.

The hazards associated with confined spaces are:

- Toxic atmosphere
- Oxygen deficiency
- Flammable atmosphere / Explosive atmosphere
- Flowing liquid
- Excessive heat

In Balmer Lawrie, most of our units have jobs being carried out in confined spaces. Proper procedure is being followed as per the sequence mentioned below:

- Training of the personnel on hazards of confined spaces
- Permit to work system
- Isolation of all possible energies
- Checking oxygen levels and monitoring LEL (lower explosive limit)
- Supervision
