## In the month of July 2020, Logistics Services successfully handled various cargo movements for esteemed customers.

Balmer Lawrie Logistics handled import consignment of 2 X 40' FR and 2 X 20' Open Top Containers for an international government run aerospace major in the month of July 2020.



The consignment was received at Cochin port and door delivered to a major PSU, under Ministry of Defence, in Bengaluru. The scope of work included customs clearance, carrying out survey at Cochin port and at the time of unloading, movement of special equipment using air suspension vehicles and deployment of cranes, crew members and offloading of containers at the PSU's premises.

Logistics Services successfully and securely moved around 2600 Kgs of valuable cargo worth of Rs. 70 crores from the Exporter's location in Bengaluru to Kempegowda International Airport under armed escort. The consignment was cleared and made ready to move in a charter flight to Israel on 31st July 2020.





Logistics Services successfully moved around 15000 Kgs of Hamsa Project cargo worth Rs. 55 crores from a major PSU, under Ministry of Defence, in Bengaluru to Kempegowda International onward Airport for movement Kaliningrad, Russia by air charter. The scope of service included movement of consignment from the PSU's premises to the airport, customs clearance, loading on charter aircraft (IL-76), operating the aircraft to Kaliningrad and delivery of the consignment at the destination airport. The charter flight was operated on 31st July 2020.

Delhi branch of Balmer Lawrie Logistics contributed to the fight against the global pandemic COVID-19 during the months of June and July 2020 by servicing our esteemed customer, a premier Medical Research Government institution. Balmer Lawrie transported COVID-19 testing facility equipment and research machinery with RV PCR kits which were critically required in India by the institute. As per the institute's website they are successfully doing 6,64,949 lakh tests daily as recorded on 5th August 2020.
