1. Introduction

Balmer Lawrie Co. Ltd under the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas is a Government of India Enterprise with its Corporate office at 21, Netaji Subhas Road, Kolkata-700 001. Industrial Packaging is a Strategic Business Unit of the Company manufacturing steel drums.

A. Instructions for bidders

 Online Single bid e-Tenders are invited from reputed manufacturers who can supply of "Degreasing, Iron Phosphating & Passivation chemical" as per detailed specification contained in Annexure IA of this tender for our plants at Silvassa, Chennai, Chittoor (AP) Asaoti(Faridabad) and Vadodara (Gujarat)

2. Please Refer to Annexure – I for detailed Technical Specifications

- 3. The tender is invited in Single-Bid System. The tender document consists of Price Bid.
- 4. All documents required in the tender can be scanned and submitted online through appropriate forms as attached in the tender.
- 5. Important points to be noted

5.1 Due date for submission of bids 23.01.2019 at 15.00 hrs.

All Bids are to be completed and to be submitted on line only in accordance with tender requirements within the duration as mentioned.

The term <u>"BL"</u> wherever mentioned in the tender document refers to <u>"Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd."</u> BL would be the Purchaser/Owner for the tendered item.

The successful bidder will be the Supplier.

This document is the Tender.

The Acceptance of the Order by the successful bidder will form the contract.

- 6. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) As per Clause no. 1 of the Special Terms & Conditions of this Tender document.
- 7. Bidders to note the Bid Rejection Criteria as detailed in 1 B (CONTENTS) Point 6, page -4.

The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the addendum / Corrigendum's issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to-time basis in the E-Procurement platform/ newspapers. The Company calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and delivery of bid including (but not limited to) costs and expenses related to visits to the site(s) and other locations, and the cost of any tests, investigations, evaluations and consultations. BL will in no case be responsible or liable for any costs regardless of the outcome of the bidding process.

The bidder is expected to examine the Tender documents, including all instructions, forms, General Terms & Conditions, Special Terms & Conditions, Technical Specifications and other documents and to fully familiarize itself with the requirements of the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all the information required by the Bidding Documents or the submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect may result in the rejection of the Bid.

3. Due Date for Submission of Bids supporting document & EMD

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E-Bidding due date and time is mentioned here under and the copies of documentary proof must be submitted to Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. 5, J. N. Heredia Marg, Ballard Estate, Mumbai – 400001, India on or before 23.01.2019 ,15.00 Hrs.

4. Late Bids

No bidding is admissible in the E.Proc platform after the bid closing date & time.

5. Bid Validity

The offer shall remain valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of the Price Bid.

6. Bid Rejection Criteria

A bid may be rejected if

- i. If the bidder fails to send the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount within the bid due date.
- ii. If the bidder does not meet the pre-qualification/technical criteria and/or non submission of documents specified.
- iii. The deviations from the terms mentioned in the document affects in any way the scope, quality and performance.
- iv. Conflict of interest between the bidder and the Company is detected at any stage.
- v. Bidders not registered under GST are not eligible for participating in this tender. Registered vendor to mandatorily provide the Provisional GST Number as per Annexure-VII and also provide proof of such registration. Offers received from bidders who are not registered under GST, will not be considered for any evaluation against this tender.

7. Clarifications

Clarifications that the Bidder needs to have on the tender specification can be sought from BL through e- mail only to be sent within one week from the date of issue of this enquiry.

8. A. Opening of Price Bid

The Price bids will be opened for those bidders only who have satisfied all Pre-Qualification criterion.

B. Complete Scope of Supply

The complete scope of work has been defined in Annexure I of the tender document. Tender Documents and Deviations

It is expected that bidders will submit bids based strictly on the terms and conditions and specifications contained in the bidding documents and will not stipulate any deviations. Deviation from technical specifications, as given in the Tender Document-Annexure – I, would invite immediate dis-qualification from further consideration of the bid.

9. Language of Bids

The Bid prepared by the bidder, all documents attached to and/or relating to the bid and all correspondence exchanged by the Bidder and BL shall be written in English language only.

Any printed literature furnished by the bidder may be written in any other language **provided that** this literature is accompanied by an authenticated English translation, in which case, for purpose of interpreting the Bid, the English translation shall govern.

10. Preparation and submission of Tender Documents

The bidders are required to fill the tender document in a format as per **Annexure III** in the E.Proc platform:

a. Price Bid (Annexure III is Price Bid)

The Price bid should not contain any information other than the price. Duties, levies charges either as % or value as estimated by BL would be applied equally to all price bids.

11. Payment Terms

The terms of payment have been defined in Clause No. 6 of Special Terms and Conditions.

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B. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): INR 16000.00

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD Rs.16,000/- (**Rs. Sixteen Thousand** only) is to be paid online as per Annexure –VIII in tender documents. Cheque and any other form of payment are not acceptable towards EMD. EMD will be refunded online to bidders account from which they paid the EMD, after finalization of tender. For accepted bidders, EMD of successful bidder can be adjusted towards Security Deposit against the Purchase order placed on them. EMD will carry no interest. Linking with earlier transactions/adjustments with pending bills or any other amount payable by the Company is not allowed.

- a) OFFERS RECEIVED WITHOUT EMD FROM NON-MSE BIDDERS WILL BE REJECTED
- b) For the successful bidder, the EMD will be refunded only after they submit the necessary Security Deposit against the work order placed on them. EMD will carry no interest.
- c) For the unsuccessful bidders, the EMD will be refunded only after the successful bidder has accepted the Purchase order and the acknowledgement of the same has been received by BL.
- d) Linking of EMD amount with earlier transactions / adjustments with pending bills or any other amount payable by the company is not allowed.

2. EMD is liable to forfeiture in the event of:

- a) Withdrawal of offers during validity period of the offer
- b) Non acceptance of orders by the bidder within the stipulated time after placement of LOI / order
- c) Any unilateral revision made by the bidder during the validity period of the offer
- d) Non execution of the prescribed documents after acceptance of the contract
- e) Non submission of Security Deposit

Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE's) with valid "Udyog Aadhar Memorandum" (UAM) number are exempted from payment of Earnest Money Deposit and eligible to participate and are also eligible for any other benefit applicable to MSE's mentioned in this tender document. Above benefit/s shall be extended only to MSE's whose UAM no. is registered with Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) and such MSE are required to submit a declaration for the same as per Annexure –VI.

Failure to submit aforementioned declaration by the bidder claiming above benefits will be treated as a non-MSE's bidder and such bid shall be cancelled accordingly.

3. Security Deposit (SD)

Security Deposit amount of **5% of basic PO Value** to be deposited by the successful Bidder in the form of Pay order / Demand Draft in favour of Balmer Lawrie& Co. Ltd, payable at Mumbai or Bank Guarantee **valid for 16 months** in BL's format (**Annexure V**).

The Security Deposit may be submitted as Bank Guarantee by a Scheduled Indian Bank within 15 days of receipt of the Purchase Order. Security Deposit can also be made directly to our Standard Chartered Bank (Account No. 222-0-526803-6, NEFT Code - IFSC "SCBL0036046) through electronic transfer and proof of transfer of funds deposited with us.

The Security Deposit if paid by Pay Order/Demand Draft shall bear no interest and shall be refunded through Bank transfer to successful bidder, only on successful delivery of the tendered item and

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All sums of compensation or other sums of money as determined, if any, payable by the bidder may be deducted from the Security Deposit.

The Security Deposit amount can be adjusted to the extent of EMD amount for the successful bidder.

4. Security deposit is liable to forfeiture in the event of:

- a) Non Supply after Acceptance of Purchase Order.
- b) Successful Bidder fails to deliver the item as per the terms & condition of the Purchase Order.
- c) Successful Bidder violates the tender conditions.
- d) If the performance of the bidder is found to be unsatisfactory

5. Validity of the Offer:

The offer shall remain valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of the Price Bid which will be normally one month from opening of Technical Bid.

6. A. Payment Terms:

Our payment terms are as follows:

Payment for the accepted material will be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of the material or bill whichever is later. Payments for supply at different locations shall be made from the respective location.

B. DEDUCTION OF TDS: TDS deducted from vendor payment will be deposited with GST authorities by 10th of the following month and TDS certificates will be issued subsequently. TDS under GST Act shall be deducted on both material as well as services. Further this TDS under GST Act is in addition to the TDS as applicable under Income Tax Act, 1961.

7. STOCKS

Successful tenderer/s shall maintain 20% of materials stock with them at any point of time at their own cost. The successful tenderer/s shall send a monthly statement to all BL-Locations in the first week of the month showing stock position that have been ordered for supply at different locations. The Company reserves the right to inspect the quantity of Degreasing , Iron Phosphating & Passivation chemicals at the tenderer's Works.

8. Delivery Period

The supplier should ensure despatch of the item as per the call-up received from each individual plants from time to time

Extension of delivery period from the successful bidder may be considered and the decision of BL would be final in this regard.

9. <u>Liquidated Damages</u>

In case, the successful bidder fails to supply the item within the stipulated period as per the Purchase Order, Liquidated Damages and not as a penalty will be imposed @ 0.50% of the value of the material, per completed week up to a maximum of 10% of the total value of the call up quantity at the sole discretion of the Tenderer.

Tenderer shall also pay to the company by way of liquidated damages and not as penalty an amount equal to loss incurred due to improper quality of Chemicals supplied subject to a maximum of 10% of the total value of the particular batch of material.

10. Award of Contract

BL shall place the Purchase order on the Lowest Quoted Bidder:

- **1.**As per the purchase policy set by Government of India for Government and PSU organizations, 25% of tendered quantity will be reserved for MSE vendors along with MSE vendors owned by SC/ST & Woman enterprenuer (MSE run by -Gen: 18%, SC/ST: 4 % & Woman Entp.: 3% respectively). Such bidders, if not L1 bidders, would be required to match with L1 rates to get the award of the alloted quantities mentioned above.
- **2.** In case of more than one such MSE bidders , the Lowest bidder will get chance to match rates with the original L1 rates in order to achieve the reserved quantity.
- 3. The balance 75% of tender quantity will be awarded to L1 bidders (Non MSE)
- **4**. In the event of non- participation by MSEs , total tendered quantity will be kept open for general bidders.
- **4.1.** In that case:
- a. Location wise Cumulative L1 would be considered on Net Delivered Value (NDV) basis and as such it would be in the interest of the bidders to quote their most competitive price.
- b. The PO quantity may be split item wise for the particular location between L1 and L2 bidders in 70:30 ratio provided the L2 bidder matches their rates with L1 rates.
- c. If L2 bidder does not agree to match rates with L1, then the L3 / L4 / L5....shall get chance to match rates with L1 in order to achieve 30% PO quantity . If none of L2/L3/L4/L5 bidder agrees to match rates with L1, then 100% PO quantity will be awarded on L1 bidder.
- d. If L1 price ties for an item or more than one item between two /more bidders for a particular location and the cumulative values also become same for the above bidders, then 100% PO quantity(ies) for that location will be split into equal ratio between the bidders. In that case, point 4.1. b will not be considered.
- e. Quantities may increase / decrease location wise up to 20% as per actual requirements.

Negotiation, if held will be only with the lowest bidder (L1 Bidder).

11. Testing / Inspection / Trial.

- I] Sampling, testing and acceptance of the material supplied shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure prescribed by the company.
- ii] It must be noted that it is not incumbent upon the company to check and test each and every lot of Chemical. The Company shall make only random checks in accordance with the procedure stated earlier. The tenderer should therefore take note of all requirements before submission of tender. Test Certificate to accompany each supply duly certifying that the Degreasing, Iron Phosphating & Passivation chemical being supplied conform to the specifications. The final acceptance/rejection of materials will be decided at the time of actual usage in the respective Plant and it will be binding on the part of the bidder to replace the rejected quantity including the quantity used till the time of identification of quality problem.

11.1 DELIVERY OF MATERIALS

- i) To all our plants at Silvassa, Vadodara, Chennai, Chittoor & Asaoti (Faridabad) (addresses given as attachment) in new Plastic stackable pail/drums of 20/30/40 Kg capacity with suitable closures. Delivery schedule given from time to time for different locations should be adhered to strictly. The supplier shall complete the supplies of ordered quantities within the stipulated period. The supplier shall ensure that all delivery challans are accompanied with the test certificate.
- ii) In case the material is not supplied as per delivery schedule, or material packing received in damaged condition/leaky/underweight, such defective product are to be replaced by supplier within 7 days of intimation. If he fails to replace, the Company reserves the right to buy the same from other tenderers who have participated in this tender, and or from domestic or international market. In such cases, the Company reserves the right to recover the extra cost, if any, incurred, from the tenderers' security and or due payment.
- iii) All costs related to unloading & stacking of material at the plant shall be at the supplier account.

12. Validity of the Contract:

The Contract if any awarded against this tender will be valid for 6 months (March'19-August'19) or till the quantity exhausts. The quoted price should be firm throughout the contract period, or till the completion of the ordered quantity, whichever is later. The spill over quantity, if any, will be carried forward. The tendered quantity may be increased / decreased by 20% as per the actual requirement.

- **13.1**. **RATE**: Please indicate rate in the Price Bid. Rates shall be inclusive of Freight/ Packing & Forwarding/ Loading & Unloading
 - 13.2 Tenderer shall quote for delivery at BL-locations mentioned In the scope of supply of this tender.
 - 13.3 Charges for Freight / Delivery to plant is inclusive with the rates to be quoted.
 - 13.4 All unloading at respective locations will be on the account of the successful bidder.

14 <u>Transit Risk Insurance</u>

Transit Risk Insurance shall be covered by the bidder from the successful bidders stock point to BL's plants.

Any failure by the bidder to do so shall place the consignment at the bidder's risk.

Successful bidder shall be fully responsible for any delay and/or demurrage of the consignment due to delay in transmittal of the dispatch documents.

C. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

The bidder means the firm or company with whom the order is placed and shall be deemed to include the bidder, successors, representatives, heirs, executors and administrators.

Whenever there is a duplication of clause in the terms and conditions, the clause which is beneficial to BL will be considered applicable at the time of any dispute.

2. Scope of Supply

Scope of Supply for the tender shall be as mentioned in Annexure IA.

3. Reference for Documentation

Purchase Order Number must appear on all correspondence, invoices, packing and on any documents or papers connected with the order.

4. Confirmation of Order

The successful bidder shall acknowledge the receipt of purchase order within 10 days following the mailing of this order in writing or through email and shall thereby confirm his acceptance of purchase order in entirely without exceptions.

5. Payment Terms

The terms of payment are as mentioned in Special Terms & Conditions Clause no.6.

6. Relaxation of Tender Terms & Conditions

BL reserves the right to relax any of the tender conditions, if necessary, while finalizing the tender at its discretion.

7. Rejection of Bids

The bid of any bidder may be rejected if a conflict of interest between the bidder and BL is detected at any state. BL reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. The decision of BL in this connection will be final.

8. Delays

8.1 Delay in Bidding

Late tenders / delayed tenders including postal delay and those not conforming to the prescribed terms and conditions will not be considered.

8.2 Delay in Delivery

The bidder shall try to complete the delivery as mentioned in the scope of work within the stipulated time. Delays in delivery or completion will attract Liquidated damages as mentioned in Special Terms & Conditions Clause no. 9.

9. Delay due to Force Majeure

In the event of causes of force Majeure occurring within the agreed delivery terms, the delivery dates can be extended by the tenderer on receipt of application from the bidder within stipulated delivery period. Only those causes that depend on natural calamities, civil wars, national strikes and strikes

/lockout at Bidder's works which have duration of more than seven consecutive calendar days are considered the causes of Force Majeure. The bidder must advise BL by a registered letter duly certified by local chamber of commerce or statutory authorities, the beginning and end of cause of delay immediately, but in no case later than 10 days from the beginning and end of such cause of Force majeure condition as defined above.

BL reserves the right to ask Bidder to suspend despatches of goods/materials covered by this order for such period as they may think fit in the event of strikes, accidents or other causes beyond BL's control.

10. Sub-Contracts

The successful bidder shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of BL. The bidder shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to BL together with the assignee, for and in respect of the due performance of the contract and the bidder's obligations there under.

11. Control Regulations

Successful bidder warrants that all goods/materials covered by this order have been produced, sold, despatched, delivered and furnished in strict compliance with all applicable laws regulations, labour agreement, working conditions and technical codes and statutory requirements as applicable from time to time. All laws and regulations required to be incorporated in executing this tender are hereby deemed to be incorporated by this reference. Owner can disown any responsibility for any irregularity or contravention of any of the statutory regulations in the manufacture or supply of goods covered in the order. The Bidder shall ensure compliance with the above and shall indemnify tenderer against any actions, damages, costs and expenses of any failure to comply as aforesaid.

12. Termination

Without prejudice to BL's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to BL, BL may terminate the Contract of any part thereof by a written notice to the bidder if :The bidder fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.

- i. The bidder informs BL of its inability to deliver the item or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- ii. The bidder fails to deliver the item within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace any rejected or defective item promptly.
- iii. The bidder becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- iv. The bidder makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- v. A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the bidder.
- vi. The bidder has misrepresented to BL, acting on which misrepresentation, BL has placed the Purchase Order on the bidder.

Upon receipt of said termination notice, the bidder shall immediately stop supply.

On termination of the contract, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to BL under the contract, in the event of BL suffering any loss on account of delayed delivery or non-delivery, BL reserves the right to claim and recover damages from the bidder in respect thereof. The EMD / Security Deposit will be forfeited .

13. Risk Purchase

In case delivery of material is not effected as per given schedule from time to time or the quality of materials suppied is not as per our specification, we reserve the right to cancel / reduce the order quantity placed on you, and procure the material from any other source and the deduction on account of penalty as well as excess mount to be incurred by us, would be recovered from the party's due payments or security amount held with us.

14. a) Arbitration

If any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Limited and the provisions of Arbitration Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final & binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract.

b) In event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provision of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Port Trusts inter se and also between CPSEs and Government Departments/Organizations (excluding disputes concerning Railways, Income Tax, Customs & Excise Departments), such disputes or difference shall be taken up by either party for resolution through AMRCD as mentioned in DPE OM no 4(1)/2013-DPE(GM)/FTS-1835 dated 22.05.2018.

Degreasing cum Phosphating, Iron Phosphating & Passivation chemicals offered shall conform to Specification given in Specification Annexure-I.

Formulation for "Degreasing Cum Phosphating Chemical" should normally include Surfactant in proper ratio to get desired result at our end. Additional requirement of Surfactant, if any, to be supplied by the vendor free of cost proportionately.

In the event of supplies not meeting the specifications, the same will be rejected.
