We invite offers in sealed envelopes from well experienced / reputed agency registered with us for lashing & chocking including tarpaulin coverage of the export cargo of about 2 Wooden Cases containing Machines and Equipment (Milling Machine) in a 20' Flat Rack Container at Balmer Lawrie CFS, Manali, Chennai. Cargo Details and scope are as follows;

1. Commodity : Machine and Equipment (Milling Machine)
 - Cargo Dim. & Gross Weight:
Case 1 : 230 x 195 x 210 CMS - Gross weight 3240 Kgs
Case 2 : 365 x 352 x 334 CMS - Gross weight 7400 Kgs

For case 1, we can change the position so as to load in 20' FR. Hence, please work out the cost accordingly.

2. Number of Containers : 1 x 20 FR
3. Scope of Work :
 - Chocking, Lashing & Proper Tarpaulin coverage of 2 Wooden Cases containing the aforesaid items in a 20' Flat Rack Container at Balmer Lawrie CFS, Manali, Chennai 600 068. Export cargo (both the boxes to be chocked, Lashed & Surveyed. Tenderer may plan the material / labour requirement based on the attached images.
 - Chocking, Lashing & Tarpaulin coverage to be carried out as per the liner's specification (COG – Centre of Gravity should be maintained during the course of action.)
 - Survey Report with sufficient photographs
 - Tentative Stuffing Plan: **Between 09th Apr 19 and 12th Apr 19**

The Successful tenderer should ensure the safety of cargo and ensure that the cases are chocked, lashed with proper Tarpaulin coverage strictly in line with the requirement of the exporter. Safety in all respect to be ensured. The tenderer shall be liable for the damage due to the negligence.

14. CLAIMS

All Claims and consequential losses arising out of the delay, detention, damage, loss in/during the course of action should be settled immediately and shall be paid by the contractor or it will be recovered from their dues.

15. JURISDICTION

All disputes or differences arising under, out of, or in connection with, the contract Shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of the relevant to the Honorable Court of Madras.

16. APPOINTMENT OF CONTRACTOR
