Any dispute or difference arising under this contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Chennai to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Limited and the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. Vendor shall warrant that all goods covered by this agreement / contract are dispatched and delivered in strict compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, labour agreements, working conditions and technical codes and requirements as applicable from time to time. The vendor shall issue the GST invoice so that equivalent amount may be availed as GST / applicable tax credit by BL. Vendor / vendor's nominated transporter shall ensure handing over of the GST paid invoice for availing concerned levy to the Company at the time of delivery of the consignment.
