2.4 <u>Security Deposit (SD)</u>

The successful contractor shall submit interest free SD of 5% of the order value rounded off to the nearest thousand subjects to a Maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/-, by a Pay Order / Demand Draft or by a Bank Guarantee from a Schedule "A" Bank towards the satisfactory execution of the order.
