1. PRODUCT SPECIFICATION:

Product Name: Ethylene Propylene Co-polymer as VII in Engine Oil/ Lubricating Oil

Product Properties:

1. The material properties shall be such that usage of vendor's recommended treat level of polymer in Mineral Oils blend(SN150) generates properties as below:
