- (ii) Balance 10 % of supply value shall be kept as retention money & will be released after completion of guarantee period without any interest or will be released against submission of performance bank guarantee of equivalent amount.



2.8 **Guarantee/Warranty Period**

12 (twelve) months from the date of successful commissioning

During this guarantee period the performance of the supplied & commissioned item has to be in line with the expected / agreed quality as per tender/PO and if not then vendor has to replace/rectify the same at no extra cost to BL to the satisfaction of BL.

2.10 Liquidated Damages
