BALMER LAWRIE & CO. LTD. (BL) invites ONLINE bids in 2 bid system from experienced & resourceful fabricators/vendors for fabrication, testing & supply of decanter module with Mechanical & electrical works and decanted oil tank as mentioned below.

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work covers generally but not limited to the followings:

- A. Fabrication, assembly of 1 no Container Module of Size 20 ft (L) X 8 ft (W) X 9 ft (H) as per the detailed Scope of Work
- **B.** Assembly and installation of 1 no Decanter Centrifuge (Free issue by BL) inside the container module.
- C. Fabrication & Installation of 1 no Mild Steel Recovered Oil tank-5 KL capacity
- **D.** Mechanical & Piping Work within the Container Module as per detailed Scope of Work & Price Schedule
- **E.** Electrical Work within the Container Module as per as per detailed Scope of Work & Price Schedule.

2.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION (PQ) CRITERIA

- i) Average annual turnover of the tenderer shall be minimum of **Rs 18 Lakh** during last three financial years ending 31st March, 2019 preferably in related business. The tenderer/bidder shall submit Balance Sheet/Profit & Loss Account for last 3 years.
- ii) The tenderer/bidder should have successfully executed work of similar nature of the following minimum values during past seven (7) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which tenders are invited:
 - a) 3 jobs each of value not less than Rs 3.6 Lakh or
 - b) 2 jobs each of value not less than Rs 4.5 Lakh or
 - c) 1 job of value not less than Rs 7.2 Lakh

Copy of work order(s) and/or completion certificate(s) should be enclosed as supportive documents. In the event of work orders from Balmer Lawrie, copy of work order may also be considered.

Similar Nature of Work shall be defined as Manufacturing or Repairing of Containers..

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- iii) Copy of PAN Card, GST Registration Certificate and shall be submitted.
- iv) Tender document duly singed and company seal (as an acceptance of all our terms and conditions) shall also be submitted
- v) `Affidavit' in non-judicial stamp paper in case of proprietorship firm, "Partnership Deed" in case of Partnership Firm, "Memorandum & Article of Association" in case of Limited Company.

3.0 DELIVERY/COMPLETION PERIOD-EX WORKS

Time is the essence of the contract. The supply of the container along with all mechanical and electrical work must be completed must be completed within **8** (**Eight**) weeks from the date of handing over of free issue item by BL at vendor's works.

However, the contract/order shall remain valid for **4 (Four) months** from the date of order.

4.0 TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tender Documents comprise two parts viz. Part-I (Un-priced) and Part-II (Priced). The Un-priced Part consists of Notice Inviting Tender, Instruction to Bidders, Detailed scope of Work and Technical Specifications. The Priced Part consists of Price Schedule.

5.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER

Tenderers shall keep their offer valid for a period of **90 (ninety) days** from the due date of this tender. Validity may be extended, if so advised by BL.

6.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT

Unpriced Bid should be accompanied by a Bank Draft of **Rs 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)** favouring `Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd.' payable at Kolkata towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).

Bidders registered as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) shall be exempted from submission of EMD (as per clause 15). Declaration of Udyog Aadhar Memorandum [UAM] number by the MSE vendors on Central Public Procurement Portal [CPPP] is mandatory to qualify for availing the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy for MSEs.

6.1 EMD of successful bidders will be retained with us till submission of Security Deposit. No interest shall be payable towards EMD amount.

6.2 For the unsuccessful bidders, the EMD will be refunded only after the successful bidder has accepted the work/purchase order and the acknowledgment of the same has been received by BL/the owner.

- 6.3 EMD is liable to forfeiture in the event of:
 - a) Withdrawal of offers during validity period of the offer
 - b) Non acceptance of orders by the bidder within the stipulated time after placement of order.
 - c) Any unilateral revision made by the bidder during the validity period of the offer.
 - d) Non-performance of the bidder during the tenure of work.
 - e) Bidders submitting false/fabricated/bogus documents in support of their credentials

7.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT

The bidder, with whom the contract is decided to be entered into and intimation is so given will have to make a Security Deposit @ 2.5% of the basic Order value in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. payable at Kolkata within 15 days from the date of intimation of acceptance of their tender, failing which Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. reserves the right to cancel the Order. Security Deposit shall be released after completion of work.

8.0 BASIS OF EVALAUTION

Bidders shall have to quote for all the items of work delineated in the Priced Schedule. In case of any unquoted item in Price Schedule, bid is liable to be cancelled. Bidders will be shortlisted through evaluation of their Unpriced Bids based on fulfilment of pre-qualification criteria i.e. submission of all required PQ documents and other required documents, EMD/MSE Certificate as per the instructions contained in the tender document. Price Bids will be opened only for the bidders whose Unpriced Bids (Part-I) are found to be acceptable.

L1 Bidder(s) will be determined based on basic amount (excluding GST). In case of any discrepancy between quoted rates and amounts. Quoted rate will prevail.

9.0 FORCE MAJEURE

Any delay in or failure of the performance of either part hereto shall not constitute default hereunder or give rise to any claims for damage, if any, to the extent such delays failure of performance is caused by occurrences such as Acts of God or an enemy, expropriation or confiscation of facilities by Government authorities, acts of war, rebellion, sabotage or fires, floods, explosions, riots, or strikes. The Vendor shall keep records of the circumstances referred to above and bring these to the notice of the Engineer-In-Charge in writing immediately on such occurrences. The amount of time, if any, lost on any of these counts shall not be counted for the delivery period. On decision of BL/Owner arrived at after consultation with the Vendor, shall be final

and binding. Such a determined period of time be extended by the Owner to enable the Vendor to deliver the items within such extended period of time.

If Vendor is prevented or delayed from the performing any of its obligations under this agreement by Force Majeure, then Vendor shall notify Owner the circumstances constituting the Force Majeure and the obligations performance of which is thereby delayed or prevented, within seven days of the occurrence of the event.

10.0 ARBITRATION

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. and the provisions of Arbitration Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final & binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract.

11.0 JURISDICTION

Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law, the courts in the city of Kolkata along shall have jurisdiction in respect of all or anything arising under this agreement and any award or awards made by the sole arbitrator

12.0 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

In case of violation/breach of any agreed terms and conditions of contract and persistently failure/negligence to observe and perform all or any of the acts, deeds, matters or things to be observed and performed by the Supplier requiring the Owner to observe or perform the same, BL may cancel/terminate this contract. In such case, the EMD and/or Security Deposit of the Supplier will be forfeited.

13.0 RIGHT OF ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION

Mere issue of tender document, participation in e-procurement portal and submission of bids does not necessarily qualify for consideration of bids. Conditional offer or offer with deviations will not be accepted. M/s Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. reserve the right to accept or reject any tender either in part or in full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

14.0 NON-CONFORMANCE

Tenders not conforming to the above mentioned requirements are liable to be rejected.

15.0 TENDER CONDITIONS FOR BENEFITS / PREFERENCE FOR MICRO & SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSES)

- As Per Public procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 issued vide Gazette Notification dated 23.03.2012 by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises of Govt. of India, MSEs must be registered with any of the following in order to avail the benefits/preference available vide Public Procurement Policy MSEs Order, 2012
 - a. District Industries Centers (DIC)
 - b. Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)
 - c. Khadi and Village industries Board and Coir Board
 - e. National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
 - f. Directorate of Handicraft and Handloom
 - g. Any other body specified by Ministry of MSME
- 15.2 MSEs participating in the tender must submit the certificate of registration with any one of the above agencies.
- 15.3 The registration certificate issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on close date of the tender. The successful bidder should ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period.
- 15.4. The MSEs who have applied for registration or renewal of registration with any of the above agencies/bodies, but have not obtained the valid certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption/preference.
- 15.5 Registered MSME vendors shall be exempted from need to furnish EMD, subject to their submission of registration details.
- 15.4 Declaration of Udyog Aadhar Memorandum [UAM Number] number by the MSME vendors on Central Public Procurement Portal [CPPP] is mandatory to qualify for availing the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy for MSMEs
- 15.5. Price Preference Subject to meeting terms and conditions stated in the tender document including but not limiting to prequalification criteria, 25% of the total quantity of the tender is earmarked for MSEs registered with above mentioned agencies/bodies for the tendered item. Where the tendered quantity can be split, MSEs quoting a price within a price band of L1+15% shall be allowed to supply 25% of total tendered quantity provided they match L1 price. In case the tendered quantity cannot be Split, MSE shall be allowed to supply total tendered quantity provided their quoted price is within a price band of L1+15% and they match the L1 price. In case of more than one such MSEs are in the price band of L1+15% and matches the L1 price, the supply may be shared proportionately.

- 15.6 Out of the 25% target of annual procurement from micro and small enterprises,4% has been earmarked for procurement from MSEs owned by SC or ST entrepreneurs and 3% from within 25% has been earmarked from supply from the MSEs owned by Woman entrepreneurs. Provided that, in event of failure of such MSEs to participate in tender process or meet tender requirement and L-1 price, 4%/ 3% sub-target for procurement earmarked for MSEs owned by SC or ST entrepreneurs and woman entrepreneurs respectively shall be met from other MSEs.
- 15.7 To qualify for entitlement as SC/ST owned MSE, the SC/ST certificate issued by District Authority must be submitted by the bidder in addition to certificate of registration with any one of the agencies mentioned in paragraph (I) above. The bidder shall be responsible to furnish necessary documentary evidence for enabling BL to ascertain that the MSE is owned by SC/ST. MSE owned by SC/ST is defined as:
 - a. In case of proprietary MSE, proprietor (s) shall be SC/ST
 - b. In case of partnership MSE, The SC/ST partners shall be holding at least 51% shares in the enterprise.
 - c. In case of Private Limited Companies, at least 51% share shall be held by SC/ST promoters.

16.0 CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The bids of any bidder may be rejected if a conflict of interest between the bidder and the company is detected at any stage.

18.0 PAYMENT TERMS

- i) **90% of basic order value** along with full taxes and duties will be paid on completion of work after inspection and certification of work by BL.
- ii) 10% of basic order value shall be paid against submission of PBG (Performance Bank Guarantee) of equivalent amount with validity of 12 months from the date of commissioning of the Decanter Module or eighteen (18) months from the date of supply whichever is earlier. PBG shall be submitted after completion of all work.

19.0 WARRANTIES & GUARANTEES

Vendor shall guarantee BL and their authorized representative against any and all defects in manufacturing, workmanship, materials and performance for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of commissioning or eighteen (18) months from the date of supply whichever is earlier. Should any defect develop during the guarantee period, it shall be remedied promptly free of charge by the Vendor and all expenses for transportation of goods necessitated for such repairs or replacement shall be borne by the vendor.

20.0 OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- i) The free issue materials such as Decanter Centrifuge, Pump, Panels and other electrical free issue items will be delivered to the vendor's premises by Balmer Lawrie's vendor. Unloading of all these free issue materials are under the scope of the tender.
- ii) After completion of work, the container is to be loaded on to designated trucks/ trailers placed by BL at vendor's premises. Loading of material on to truck/ trailer is to be done by the vendor.
- iii) Inspection of work is to be carried out by Balmer Lawrie at vendor's premises. Vendor shall make all necessary arrangements for inspection of work as per BL's instructions, without any additional charge.

21.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

A reduction @0.5% of the basic order value per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 5% of the basic order value will be applicable for delay in completion of work.

22.0 TAXES & DUTIES

GST shall be mentioned separately as per price schedule. Any taxes and duties other than GST shall be included in the basic rate. Prices should be firm till completion of the job and no escalation for whatsoever reason shall be granted. Our GST Registration No. 19AABCB0984E1ZS for the state of West Bengal.

1.0 PROCEDURE FOR BID SUBMISSION

The Tender Document comprises of two Bids viz Unpriced Part – I and Priced Part – II. The submission of offer can only be made through e-bidding as per following guidelines::

1.1 BID SUBMISSION

The bidders shall submit their response through bid submission to the tender on e-Procurement platform at https://balmerlawrie.eproc.in by following the procedures given below. The bidder would be required to register on the e-procurement market place https://balmerlawrie.eproc.in and submit their bids on line. The bidders shall submit their offers comprising the Tender Document (Part-I), duly filled up (wherever required), stamped and signed along with all pre-qualification documents, EMD. The bidders shall download the tender document, upload the same along with scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc., duly filled in, stamped and signed, in support of their eligibility criteria/NIT in the e-Procurement web site. However, bulky documents which could not be uploaded may be sent along with Unpriced Bid (Part-I) of the Tender Document, duly stamped and signed to the Tender Inviting Authority before date of tender opening along with the bank draft towards EMD amount (unless otherwise MSME). DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK & TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

A. Fabrication, Assembly of Container Module

Size	20 ft X 8ft X 9 ft (L X B X H)
Shell	The outer shell shall be manufactured from HR Sheet of IS 1079 or IS 513 or equivalent and of welded construction. The components of various profiles shall be made out from 3.2 / 4.0 / 5.0 mm thickness.
	The shell shall have Corner Casting at all corners to facilitate for easy handling. The container shall have closed structure made out of hollow sections positioned vertically at corners and intermediate positions along the periphery. Horizontal tie members with hollow section shall be provided at bottom, middle and top levels i.e. at 3 layers. Cross beams made of rectangular hollow sections shall be provided at bottom level to erect the recovered oil tank on it. Cross beams shall also be provided at about +1400 mm height (Top of Steel) from container bottom to erect the decanter centrifuge on it.
Walls	The side and end wall panel shall be vertically corrugated steel sheet of 1.6 / 2.0 mm thickness. The corrugated panels are continuously butt welded to form part of Side/end walls.
	However, part of Side walls & end wall shall be made out of segregated reinforced framed MS panels which can be opened during operation of the decanter. All the cut out after fixing the container module shall be weather tight. One end wall shall be provided with full height two leaf main door with locks. The door shall be effectively sealed against water ingress in closed condition by using rubber gasket profiles.
Roof	The roof shall be self-draining type. The roof of the shell shall be manufactured from minimum 2.0mm thick plain MS sheet conforming to IS 1079 or IS 513 or equivalent. External roof Panels shall be FRP coated. The roof shall made in separated framed panels and openable type for de-erection/removal of the decanter centrifuge.
Welding	The Shell of the structural cabin shall be of all weld construction. The welding is to be carried out by MIG process using CO2 as shielding gas. All the external welding shall be continuous, uniform and of full penetration.
Floor	This Container's floor shall have 3 mm MS sheet on structural cross members.
Surface Prep.	The shell shall be undergone for surface preparation through sand blasting. The dust and dirt's are to be removed by blowing dry and clean oil free compressed air before application of spray painting.
Painting	Painting of container as per Specification for painting mentioned below.

	Transportation of the container will be carried out by BL. Loading of the container onto BL's designated truck trailer after completion of work
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Specifications for Painting for the Container

The specifications for painting of containers shall be as follows:

i) Surface Preparation : Entire surface of all structural members shall be

properly cleaned through scrapping and power brushing as required to expose the bare metal

surface.

ii) Painting: : The cleaned steel surface shall be painted by spray

painting process.

iii) Inner & Outer surface: : Two coats of Polyurethane based paint over one

coat of zinc rich primer.

iv) Under frame and surface: : Bituminous paint over one coat of zinc rich primer.

v) Thickness of Painting : The aggregate painting thickness shall not be less

than 110 micron DFT for all the above categories.

v) Shade & Logo : Shade of paint will be confirmed by BL later. After

painting, Logo of Balmer Lawrie/ Oreco, 4 Nos. to

be painted on the container.

B. Assembly and Installation of 1 No Decanter Centrifuge (Free issue by BL)

1) Unloading of the consignment related to the Decanter Centrifuge and storing of the same at safe place at vendor's works.

- 2) Assembly of the decanter centrifuge as per the technical supervision of Original Equipment Manufacturer's engineer with supply of necessary tools, tackles and manpower as required.
